

STAGE 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT WCID No. 17 is enforcing twice-per-week watering



Stage 1 - Baseline Water Conservation

- >900,000 Acre-Feet Combined Storage
- Twice per Week Watering

Stage 2 - Moderate Water Shortage

900,000 - 750,000 Acre-Feet

- Once per Week Watering

Stage 3 - Severe Water Shortage

750,000 - 600,000 Acre-Feet

- No Watering Allowed

Stage 4 - Critical Water Conditions

600,000 Acre-Feet

- No Watering Allowed

With the combined storage of Lake Buchanan and Lake Travis above 900,000 acre-feet, we are currently in Stage 1 which means a maximum of twice per week watering.

Your watering days are based on your address ending number:

Monday & Thursday: 0, 1, 2, 3 (Res)

Tuesday & Friday: 4, 5, 6 (Res)

Tuesday & Friday: Commercial/HOAs

Wednesday & Saturday: 7, 8, 9 (Res)

Sunday no automated systems are allowed

All watering should occur a maximum of two days a week on your designated day.

Approved hours are between 12 a.m. – 10 a.m. and

7 p.m. – 12 a.m. on your authorized day.

Note: Above-ground (hose-end) sprinklers allowed once on designated day between hours of 12 a.m. - 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. - 12 a.m.

Hand-held hose watering is allowed any day but NOT between 10 a.m. - 7 p.m.
