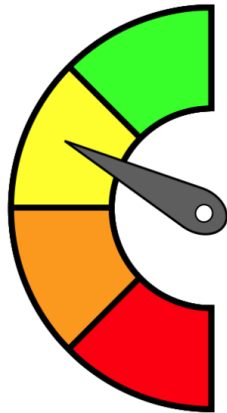




STAGE 2 WATER RESTRICTIONS IN EFFECT WCID No. 17 is enforcing once-per-week watering



Stage 1 - Baseline Water Conservation
- Twice per Week Watering

Stage 2 - Moderate Water Shortage
- Once per Week Watering

Stage 3 - Severe Water Shortage
- No Watering Allowed

Stage 4 - Critical Water Conditions
- No Watering Allowed

LCRA has moved to Stage 2 of its Drought Contingency Plan, effective immediately. While combined storage of Lakes Travis and Buchanan is above 900,000 acre-feet, the winter inflows into the Highland Lakes have been lower than 25% of the historical average. Under the LCRA's drought contingency plan this requires us to automatically move to Stage 2 Drought Contingency controls.

Irrigation is now allowed only ONE day per week, based on the last digit in address.

- **Monday - 0, 1, (Res)**
- **Tuesday - 4, 5, 6 (Res)**
- **Wednesday - 7, 8, 9 (Res)**
- **Thursday - 2, 3 (Res)**
- **Friday - Commercial/HOAs**
- **Saturday - No automated systems allowed**
- **Sunday - No automated systems allowed**

Note: Above-ground (hose-end) sprinklers are allowed on designated day between the hours of 12 a.m.-10 a.m. All watering should occur a maximum of one day per week between the hours of 12 a.m.-10 a.m. and 7 p.m.-12 a.m. **Hand-held** hose or Bucket watering is allowed any day but NOT between 10 a.m.-7 p.m.

Customers who violate the guidelines are subject to fines and could have their water service disconnected.
